New Membership Opportunities

Partner-Buddy Membership

Discounted rate for two friends to join together. Each receives 10 percent off their dues for the first year. This membership is only for people age 30 and older as new members or former members who have been inactive for two or more years.

Graduated Scale Membership

Pay only 80 percent of your dues the first year, then 90 percent in year two, and the regular rate for the third year. In this category, the participant must be willing to sign a document stating that they will remain a member for the full three year plan, or be willing to pay the difference between the discount and the regular rate should the participant leave the club before the end of three years. Again, this program is open to those age 30 and older who are new members or former members who have been inactive for two or more years.

Young Adult Membership

For ages 19-29, full membership privileges for only \$609 for the entire year, or \$50.75 a month. Enjoy all golf and clubhouse benefits and no food minimum for the first year. Visit lewistowncountryclub.com for an application or call 242-2544 for details.

Our "Ole Gang" playing golf through the month of December is not going to get us there. As a matter of fact the younger members need to figure out how to replace us in the future.

Currently with low play and finances we have Eric on temporary layoff. As we get closer to the start up of a new season, we will bring Eric back along with others as we need them to do necessary repairs to equipment and get ready for start up of a new season.

The club will also be establishing a committee to develop a new hole sponsorship program. Most of our current program has now expired. Contact Don Attick if you have suggestions or questions.

The new minimum of \$125 per quarter covered in last month's letter is for ALL resident and non resident members. Again, it will start in April end in June and start in July and end in September.
