Tip of the Month

Since I have been told our greens are faster this year than in past years, I thought this would be a good topic. The first rule of fast greens is that putts will break more when they are faster, so adjust for more break. Also, remember that any putts that miss below the hole will run out more than putts missed above the hole. So, don't be afraid to play too much break. Second, a shorter stroke with a better strike will help you to judge the speed better.

We have been making some improvements to the irrigation system, mainly adding valves and replacing quick couplers (or snap valves) with pop up sprinkler heads.

We still have some digging to do at numbers 2 and 3 greens, the chipping green, and around number 4 tee area.

We will be getting a new tree to replace the white birch that is currently still standing in the island bed in the parking lot. The new tree will be a Japanese lilac.

On Monday, June 7 we will be dry-jecting the greens. We will close holes 6, 7, 8, and the back nine. Once these holes are completed, we will open them back up and then close holes 1-5 and 9. We apologize for the inconvenience and hope that you can rearrange your schedule to accommodate our schedule for just this one day.
